## JUST SA GREEN ECONOMY AND JUST TRANSITION TRAINING DURING 2025

# KOMATI COMMUNITY AND STAKEHOLDER DIALOGUE SESSION

TIPS is preparing an economic diversification strategy for the area around the Komati power station. A first draft has been completed and key findings wereshared with community representatives and stakeholders on 27<sup>th</sup> November 2025 in Blinkpan, Mpumalanga. The engagement hosted an estimate of 100+ attendees from various communities in the area. A second draft of the report is underway and will be submitted to the PCC early next year.



#### MPUMALANGA TOURISM STUDY

With the planned decommissioning of Eskom coal-powered generators in the region, alternative economic opportunities in this area must be supported, where feasible. As part of our research on economic diversification, we commissioned research on tourism in the Coalfields region of Mpumalanga. The study reviews the state of tourism in the area, lessons from post-mining tourism elsewhere in the world, and potential development pathways for tourism in the Coalfields.

## JUST SA INTERNATIONAL STUDY TOUR FOR LOCAL AND PROVINCIAL GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS IN 2026

We are excited to reconnect with you as a valued alumnus of the JUST SA Green Economy and Just Transition Training Programme. Building on your commitment to a just, inclusive, and sustainable transition in South Africa, we are pleased to invite you to apply for a unique opportunity to participate in our International Study Tour to India in 2026.

#### **About the International Study Tour**

The primary objective of the JUST SA International Study Tour (IST) is to equip South African local government leaders, planners, and policy advisors with practical knowledge, comparative insights, and tools from global best practices in implementing a Just Transition at the municipal level.

The tour will provide selected local and provincial government officials the opportunity to learn firsthand from international best practices in Just Transition. Through site visits, policy dialogues, and peer exchanges, participants will engage with other national and subnational practitioners in the green economy and just transition space in another country.

The study tour is planned for **mid-October 2026** (final dates to be confirmed). One representative from either local or provincial government will be selected from each of South Africa's nine provinces. JUST SA will cover participants' travel and accommodation expenses. Non-financial support will be provided to assist with the visa application process (visa requirements, letters of support, etc.) but successful applicants will be expected to arrange (and pay for) their own visas.

We look forward to receiving your application and to providing participants with an action- orientated learning experience.
