


"Reaping the Potential of Entrepreneurship for a Climate-Smart Inclusive Green Economy in South Africa" (ECSIGE)

One of such enterprises is a six-month offline and online academy called the Emergent Business and Coding Academy that trains young women from low-income communities with entrepreneurship, agricultural and computer literacy skills so that they become self-sustainable.











IMPACT OF COVID-19 SINCE MARCH 2020






What is the most likely effect of COVID-19 on your business in the short term




- It will be business a usual for us, no anticipated impact.


