
A European Green Deal

Striving to be the first climate-neutral continent

Climate change and environmental degradation are an existential threat to Europe and the world. To overcome these challenges, the European Green Deal will transform the EU into a modern, resource-efficient and competitive economy, ensuring:

- no net emissions of greenhouse gases by 2050
- economic growth decoupled from resource use
- no person and no place left behind





Through EU and EU Member States in SA:

- Need for policy reform to create enabling environment – Government budgets must follow transition and recovery
- Public and private financing from EU will support transition and recovery
- Must be a knowledge-based transition
- Diplomacy effrots to create awareness and support reform and recovery
